

How Ravens Wood School measures and assesses the impact of the careers provision on students.

The impact of the Careers Provision at Ravens Wood School is assessed regularly. The school has a number of ways of doing this.

We identify and analyse the destinations of our year 11 and 13 students taking in to account their prior attainment.

For Year 11 we record pathways including:

- All Further Education choices including sixth form, college and apprenticeships.
- Outcomes are analysed to ensure the advice is relevant to the local LMI and to ensure that we promote equal opportunities.

For Year 13 students we identify and analyse whether students:

- Go onto higher education and the range of courses being studied and the universities/colleges being secured.
- Go on to an apprenticeship and the levels secured.

We are very keen to get the views of students on the careers provision (CEIAG) at Ravens Wood School. We ask all year 11 and 13 students to complete an on-line survey to find out their views on elements of the careers provision. We evaluate this and enhance the provision where needed.

We value the views of parents on how well we have helped them to support their children make rational informed career decisions. A whole school parent survey is sent to parents in the Autumn term; this includes a number of questions relating to the Careers Provision.

Business volunteers are asked for their feedback on careers events that they take part in, this could include the careers fair, employer talks and workshops. Our Careers Hub Business Enterprise volunteers also evaluate the careers provision from a business point of view and give regular feedback.
