Example:

- Rock n Roll 1950-1960
- Location of Origin: Ohio, United States
- Notable Artists: Elvis Presley, Bill Haley and the Comets
- Notable Songs: Jailhouse Rock, Blue Suede Shoes
- Notable features: use of 12 bar blues chord sequence, simple structure, fast tempo for dancing, lyrics referring to teen life/love.
