



Post-16 Pathways

At Ravens Wood School we ensure that our students are supported with up to date information, advice and guidance to inform their next step decision. Here are the common pathways for most Ravens Wood students:

- The majority of students stay on at Ravens Wood School and continue to study A Levels and BTEC Level 3 qualifications – click on the link to take you to the post 16 section on the school website - <https://www.ravenswood.bromley.sch.uk/post-sixteen/>
- A small number of students choose a new post-16 setting at other local Sixth Form schools or colleges – open events showcasing these normal take place in the Autumn term.
