What to do on Results Day

As you are an internal RWS applicant, you will be invited into school from 08.30 until 11am, at which point we welcome external applicants to apply.

- Ensure you are able to log into Appicaa before results day – you will need this on the day
- Collect your results from **08.30am** as well as a ticket for your face-to-face enrolment meeting
 - Log into Appicaa and **accept your offer** whilst you wait

- Please ensure you have sufficient data on your phone. There will be a limited number of laptops available to support but there will be a wait for these

FAQs

I have enrolled at another school. Can I still enrol at RWS?

If you have used Appicaa to enrol elsewhere, you will be unable to proceed with your RWS application. Please see [Student Enrolment Guide](#) for support

I can't be there in person on results day, how do I enrol?

You should send an email to enrolment@rws.uk.net nominating an adult to enrol on your behalf. This should be done before Friday 17th July. They will need to bring photo ID on the day.

I would like to enrol in a different subject to my application. Is this possible?

Yes, subject to entrance criteria and availability and this can be discussed during your face-to-face meeting. In case of over subscription, we would follow our Admission Policy guidance. You will also be expected to complete the Pre Course task for your new subject before term commences.

When does term start?

Y12 students will start on Wednesday 2nd September at 08.30

I am unsure about one of the subjects I have chosen, can I change course?

Students are able change subjects in the first two weeks of term, subject to entrance criteria and availability. This is to avoid students missing too much course content in the new subject.
